2024-2025 Financial Report

- Fiscal year runs from Nov. 1st to Oct. 31st, so that fall sports can be covered from the year before's funds
- There are funds on this year's budget that will not have been dispersed yet:
 - Cross Country hasn't submitted anything for the season yet
 - Volleyball still has a tournament to submit
 - Soccer field rental expense
 - All fall senior banners yet to be paid
 - No Softball team this year
- Non-budgeted expenditures: Coach training and snacks to stock the concession stand
- SLPS sends Hometown App ticket sales and concession funds to Metro's account
- Approved

2025-2026 Budget

- School funds are hard to access
 - Checks can't be written in time
 - Vendor has to be on approved district list
 - Will use school funds whenever we can
- Hometown App
 - Required by district

- Only get ticket money for home games against non-SLPS teams
- Used for concessions too
- Money is sent to Metro's account and Dr. T keeps a record of available Athletics funds in the school account
- Need fundraisers
 - Last year's Bud's Pizza fundraiser was successful and could be repeated
 - Have to avoid PTO fundraiser times
 - City II games
 - Top Golf
 - Sponsors
 - State might have restrictions, like no sponsors listed on competition uniforms
- Winter Sports haven't spent much in the past
 - Encouraging them to access these funds
 - Basketball asked for warm-ups and/or practice jerseys, but that might be an individual expense
- Uniforms
 - District replaces every 3 years
 - Boosters help to replace damaged or missing uniforms, additional sizes, etc.
 - Hats for baseball team
 - School found some new ones, Arens has them
 - Could get extras for Spirit Shop
- Expenses due to school not having not having a large campus
 - Soccer practice field is free unless Forest Park has an event. Then, they have to rent Central Fields
 - Tennis has to get memberships to Tower Grove Park
 - Batting cages for baseball
- Budget Passed
